## Practice Makes Catholic - Did you know?

Do you frequently hear people say that Catholics don't read the Bible?

The Catholic Church has a 3-year cycle of readings. These are contained in the lectionary & are divided into years A, B & C. A cycle begins either on the 1st Sunday of Advent, which falls either on the last Sunday of November or the 1st Sunday of December. We are in Cycle A. B follows A & C follow B & back to A.

A lectionary is a book containing a collection of scripture readings appointed for worship on a given day or occasion. At every Catholic Church, in every country, on every day, the same reading will occur.

In each three-year period the Catholic Church reads the entire Bible. This is the Epistles, the Old Testament readings & the Gospels. The readings for the week are posted in our bulletin so that you may read in advance.

This is information that should arm you with an answer when anyone asks you if you read the Bible. Answer yes, yes we do

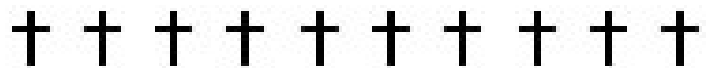
