

Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity | Year A
June 4th, 2023 (Ex 34:4b-6, 8-9 | 2 Cor 13:11-13 | John 3:16-18)

Moses bows down in worship to the Lord God and prays that the wickedness and sins of his stiff-necked people be pardoned and that God receive them as his own. Let us pray to God.

1/ Daniel sings the song of God being praised and exalted above all forever. We pray that the faithful throughout the world, led by Pope Francis, pastors, and deacons, may never cease to give praise to the Most Triune God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Let us pray.

2/ The Corinthian Christians are urged to mend their ways, to agree with one another, to live in peace, and to greet one another with a holy kiss. For people of differences, especially those who are politically different. We pray that, just as the Triune God is in three Persons, but united in one substance, so people may discern to live in peace with one another. Let us pray.

3/ Paul prays that the grace of Jesus, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with each and all members of the Corinthian Church. For all of us Christians and God-fearing people. We pray that we may not receive the love of God, the grace of Jesus, and the blessing of the Holy Spirit in vain. Let us pray.

4/ God so loved the world that he sent his Son Jesus, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish, but might have life eternal. For our sisters and brothers who labored in life with faith in God and Jesus, but have now departed from us. We pray that God grant them pardon of sins and resurrection to heaven.
