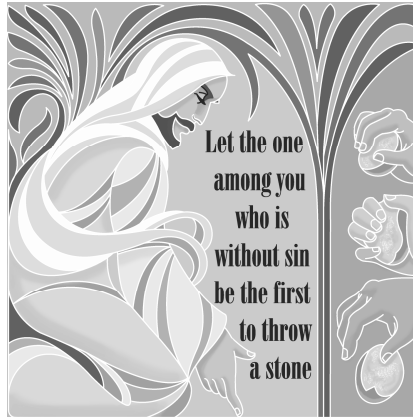

### Practice Makes Catholic - Did you know?

Many Catholics are not fully aware of the six precepts of the Catholic Church. These are the most basic of obligations that we hold. Today, we will be looking at the 2nd precept.

"You shall confess your sins at least once a year". This is listed in the catechism #2042. While we should regularly take the opportunity to partake of reconciliation, it is required to confess our sins during Lent in preparation for Easter. This can be a daunting task because it is difficult in our human nature to admit our faults. The rewards far outweigh any discomfort.

A peace that transcends our understanding is the gift we receive from the spirit for letting go of our sins. Remember some of the most frequently used words in the Bible... be not afraid.. this may be an obligation but it is our gift from God.
