A doll sized violin in a case, because she plays the violin & loves music. A dolls Hawaiian shirt because her daddy, who died in January, always wore one. As her last item she chose a rosary. She said she chose that because not only is she a Christian, which she could have shown by bringing the cross, but that she is a Catholic.

As a 13 year old in a public school in a large city, she wanted them to know that this rosary was blessed by the Pope, at the Vatican & that her prayer life & that rosary were important to her.

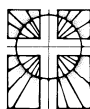
Having her do that is really why we do what we do. To teach our children & to have them go out into the world & Proclaim their faith in Jesus.
