A good resource book for how to do that is *Catholicism and Fundamentalism* by Karl Keating.

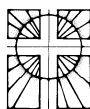
Evangelizing means knowing the truth about history and counteracting misconceptions about our traditions. It is part of what we should be doing as Catholics.
