According to the general Roman Missal 'peace be with you' or the rite of peace, entreats peace and unity for herself, the church, the whole Human family, and the faithful to express to each other their Ecclesiastical communion and mutual charity before communicating in the Blessed Sacrament.

As for how the actual sign of peace to be given the manner is to be established by the conference of Bishops in accordance with the culture and customs of the people. However, it is appropriate for each person to offer, in a somber manner, a sign of peace to those who are nearest. This may include vocally wishing to each other the greeting of peace be with you.
