A crucifix is a cross that has a corpus or body representing Christ and the suffering placed upon it. Christians & other faith denominations, proclaim that their Christ is risen. The crucifix remind us all of the price Christ paid for our Redemption.

The open arms of Jesus welcome & embrace us as we enter to celebrate the Eucharist. Our crucifix is placed in a position of honor where Christ is directly in line with the altar or Tabernacle.

This reminder of his sacrifice makes it more poignant when we think of the directive of Jesus when he says "Deny yourselves. Take up your cross daily, and follow me." Matthew 16:22-28
