New Opportunity for Feedback to the Synod
The "Interim Stage" for the Synod on Synodality is the period between Synod of Bishops' meetings in October 2023 and October 2024. All are invited to participate in consultation that will contribute to preparation for the October 2024 Assembly in Rome. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has recommended that dioceses conduct two to three listening sessions during Lent.
