Why do we genuflect

When entering the church Roman Catholic pause and Genuflect, which is a bending of the right knee to the floor. It signifies adoration and is reserved for the Most Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle and during liturgical celebrations in Lent before the cross or on Good Friday up until the Easter Vigil.

We also bow or genuflect at the mention of the word incarnate during the Nicene Creed and before receiving Holy Communion." At the name of Jesus every knee should bend" Philippians 2:10
