The sign of the cross originated in the early church probably starting with the sign being used during baptism and when Saint Paul stated in Galatians 6:17 "that his body was marked with the sign of Christ's cross".

We celebrate claiming ourselves for Jesus. It is a confession of Faith to a renewal of baptism, a mark of discipleship for a defense against the devil and a victory over Self Indulgence.

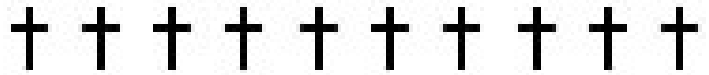
