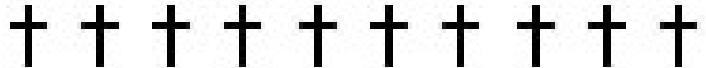

Practice Makes Catholic - Did you know?

What is holy water and for what is it used?

Holy water is water that has been blessed by a priest and is used for various religious purposes, such as baptisms, blessings, dedications, and exorcisms.

At the beginning of Mass holy water it's commonly found in a receptacle called a stoup or a font at the entrance of the church. It is also used in private homes so that the family may bless themselves with it.

Holy water is a reminder of our baptism in Christ Jesus and our baptismal promises...
