Practice Makes Catholic - Did you know?

Talents are gifts that God gives us to enjoy, but we enjoy them even more once they're shared. Every gift we have been given is meant not just for ourselves, but to be passed along to others. Carrie Gress (Nudging Conversions)

In Matthew 25:14-30, Jesus reminds his disciples with the parable about the talents, to not hide our talents or to bury them in the ground. A talent in Jesus' time was worth about \$363. Today that same Talent, depending on which conversion method you use, is worth \$283 million or \$1,641,000. Not much to sneeze about is it? It also refers to our personal talents.

We are reminded to invest & use our money as well as the many gifts with which we are blessed with others. This concept is Revisited in other places in the Gospels. Matthew 5:14-15, Mark 4:21-25 & Luke 8:16 -18... we are asked repeatedly to share our gifts. Maybe your gift is nursing, or you can drive someone to the doctor, or care for children or teach or build a house. Sometimes the greatest gift is just being available to others.
Search your Heart.

Sharing our talents, whatever they may be, it's how we show we belong to Jesus. It's why we do what we do. WDWD isn't just about the rituals & traditions that we share but about everything we do that proclaims we are Disciples of Jesus.
