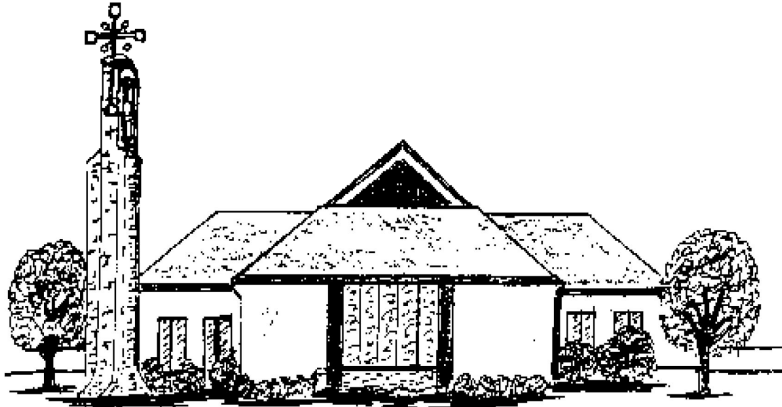

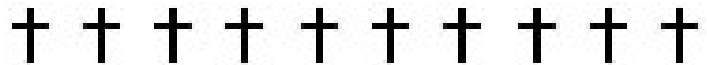

Usher's

People generally tend to disregard ushers as a ministry at Mass, this is far from true. If you have ever walked into Church & are looking for somewhere to sit you would be very thankful to an usher. Usher's make sure people get seated, occasionally set up extra seating, & prepare bulletins to be distributed at the end of Mass.

Usher's are most visible when they take up the collection. The collection is our way of paying the bills. The lights, air conditioning, heat, all need to be paid for. The ushers gather these contributions together & present them to the priest. They make sure the gifts of bread & wine are brought to the priest at the same time.

While we do have people who are assigned as gift bearers usher's will fill in or find replacements if needed. In many parishes the ushers dismiss rows as we go to communion. As you leave the church, ushers hand out bulletins & wish you a pleasant day. Hospitality, that is part of the ministry of ushers.

If you have ever wondered if you would like to participate in this ministry know that it is vital to the entire service, from beginning to end. Its part of why we do what we do.
