(Corpus Christi)**  
Mark 14:22-24

“While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, and said, “Take it; this is my body.” Then he took a cup, gave thanks and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, “This my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many.”

**Practice Makes Catholic - Did you know?**

Today is the feast and celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ.

Within our Catholic Doctrine, we believe in the transubstantiation that occurs when the Eucharist is celebrated at Mass. The bread and wine in fact becomes the true body and blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Jesus told his disciples “this is my body, this is my blood”.. during the consecration these simple everyday gifts of the harvest transform into the true presence of Jesus.
