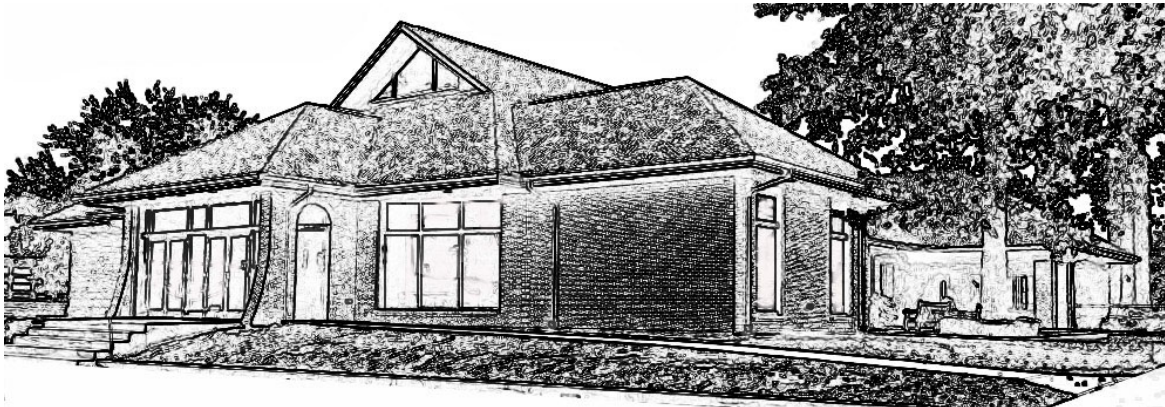

Catechesis - About Liturgy

LITURGICAL GYMNASTICS

Some Roman Catholics take liturgical rubrics a bit too far. Like the Sadducees of ancient history, they focus on the letter of the law and miss the spirit of it entirely.

We see this quite often in concerns about the Eucharist and the consecrated host and wine. What if a Eucharistic minister drops the host or someone receiving from the cup spills some of the wine? Those who are overly focused on the letter of the law respond with an answer that attends solely to the Body of Christ in the Eucharistic species while ignoring completely the Body of Christ in the person of the minister or the communicant.

We absolutely must take care of the sacred gifts of the Eucharist. But the very reason we show so much reverence to the Body and Blood of Christ is because Jesus was one of us, and through the Eucharist in which we share his Body and Blood, WE BECOME ONE WITH HIM. If we bend over backward to follow the letter of the law in order to honor the Body of Christ in the Eucharist while disregarding the spirit of the law that calls us to care for the Body of Christ in the person before us, we have missed the point of the law altogether.
