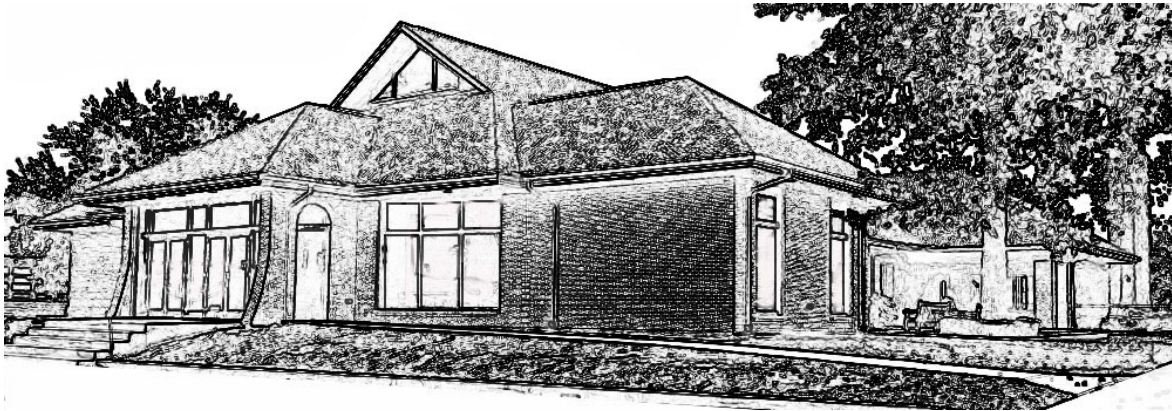

Catechesis - About Liturgy

"Pastoral care of the sick"

In all of the prayers & liturgical texts concerning the pastoral care of the sick, the church stresses the importance of those who suffer from illness. Unlike our society that measures the worth of a person by their power or by what they can achieve, those who are sick, by their very weakness, ARE VISIBLE SIGNS OF THE MYSTERY OF CHRIST'S SUFFERING & RESURRECTION. In their very bodies, they carry both the wounds of Christ & the promise of salvation.

As we pray for the sick & for their recovery, we understand that the Christian approach to healing isn't primarily about bodily restoration - although that is always our hope. The healing that Jesus gives is a restoration of the one who is sick back into the assembly of the faithful. Illness, no matter how minor, isolates us in some way from our family, friends & the community. We are unable to do the things we normally do when we are well. Especially when we are very ill, we can't join with the assembly to give thanks in the celebration of the Eucharist.

Weekly, the church members who are living in our nursing homes, assisted living centers, etc. are able to receive Holy Communion. Three to four times a year, they are anointed. They are receiving solid, pastoral care.
