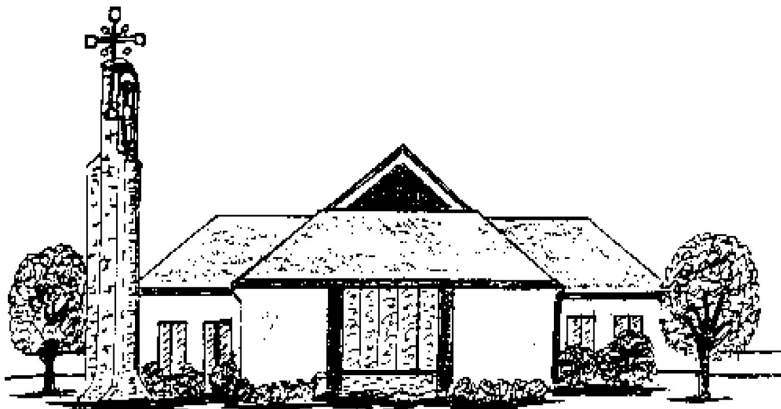

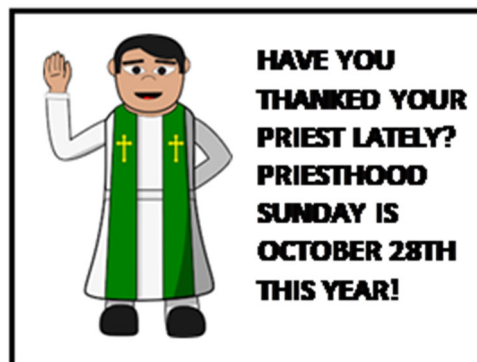
## Community News
