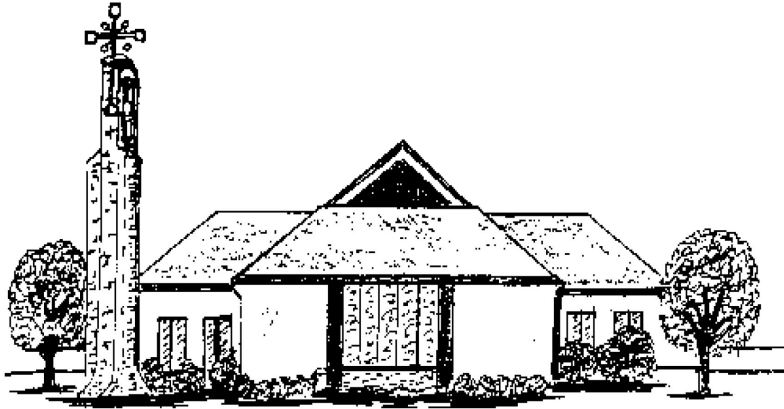

Did you say a prayer that your heart will be open to what God has to say to you today?

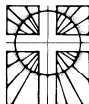
