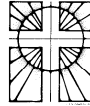

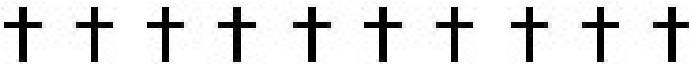

Parish Council Selection Process. Nominations are now open for (2) three year positions. All nominations are subject to the approval of the pastor. Nominations are open until October 1.

The Parish Council is an advisory body to the pastor on areas of parish life. To serve on the Parish Council you must be at least 18 years of age; a fully initiated (Received the Sacraments of Initiation) registered member of the parish; and a Catholic in good standing. The new members will be chosen using a selection process rather than an election process.

To nominate yourself or someone else, please complete the form below and return to the Parish Office no later than Monday, October 1. If you nominate someone other than yourself, you must first obtain that person's permission. Each person nominated will be contacted because each nominee must accept the nomination to be considered for the council.
