In an effort to fulfill this commitment, all new employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth (18 and under) for ANY length of time are required to participate in one of the 2-hour Safe Environment workshops. If you are a current volunteer, you are required to update their background check and take the online Safe Environment refresher course every 5 years. The next scheduled in-person training will be held on 7/29/24 at the Saffin Center, 3938 Poplar Level Rd., Louisville, KY 40213, at 6:30 p.m. There's no pre-registration required.
